

TOWN OF TOFIELD

BY-LAW NUMBER 1270

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW NUMBER 1262 OF THE TOWN OF TOFIELD.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to amend the Community Standards Bylaw 1262,

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, S.A. 1994, the Council of the Town of Tofield, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, **ENACTS**, as follows:

2. **Definitions**

- Delete:** 2.6 in its entirety
- Add:** 2.6 **"Dismantled Vehicle"** means a motor vehicle or trailer or Recreational Vehicle that has become dilapidated or disassembled which may include but not limited to flat tires, missing tires and rims, fenders, doors, windows, hoods, trunks, and boxes.
- Add:** 2.18 **"Trailer"** means a vehicle so designed that it *may be attached to or drawn by a motor vehicle or tractor, and is intended to transport property or persons*, and includes any vehicle defined by regulation as a trailer but does not include machinery or equipment solely used in the construction or maintenance of highways;
- Delete:** 4.1(g) in its entirety
- Add:** 4.1 (g) no person shall park a motor vehicle, recreational vehicle or a trailer in the front yard setback, as defined in the Land Use Bylaw, unless the motor vehicle, recreational vehicle or trailer is parked on a defined driveway. Failure to comply with this section shall result in the motor vehicle, recreational vehicle or trailer being towed at the Registered Owners expense.
- 4.2 (c) Whenever snow, ice, dirt or any obstruction forms or is deposited on the sidewalk or sidewalks adjoining any premises occupied or not occupied by any person, or belonging to an owner not residing in the Town, whether natural or body corporate, all owners or occupants of all premises adjoining or offsetting the sidewalks shall clear away such snow, ice, dirt or other obstructions from the adjoining and offsetting premises within 24 hours after the time when the snow, ice, dirt or other obstructions was deposited or formed on the said sidewalk.
- (d) The owner(s) or occupant(s), as the case may be, are jointly and severally responsible for clearing the sidewalks as provided in 4.2 (c).
