REGULATIONS REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION AND USE OF FIRE PITS

The use of fire pits to confine an outdoor fire for the purpose of cooking, warmth, or entertainment is becoming a popular backyard activity in the Town of Tofield. For the purpose of the construction and use of a fire pit the following requirements are requested;

- 1. A sketch showing your lot, with the location of the buildings, decks, fences, and the location of the proposed fire pit.
- 2. The base and sides of the pit be constructed of non-combustibles.
- 3. The pit should be no greater than 32" in diameter and a minimum of 12" deep.
- 4. The minimum distance to any structure, fence, or deck will 10 feet.
- 5. The outlet of the burning pit be covered by an 8 gauge steel mesh at all times while burning.
- 6. The property owner/occupant will be held responsible for any damage and costs resulting from the use of a fire pit.

NOTE: The following precautions shall be noted by the owner/occupier;

- 1. The fire pit must be supervised by an adult at all times when in use.
- 2. The owner/occupier must insure that the smoke from the pit does not bother the neighbours.
- 3. Sufficient precautions must be taken to ensure that the fire can be kept under control at all times, and shall not be left unattended.
- 4. There shall be no burning of grass, weeds, garden refuse, garbage, or other similar materials that may give off noxious fumes or smoke.
- 5. Out door fires are not to be used as smudge fires.
