Council announces exciting new projects as summer winds down



September brings our children back to school, cooler temperatures, a close to summer, and a close to a very busy construction season in Tofield. The community has been bustling with activities from events to roadwork and has made for what we believe to be a very successful 2022, with 3 plus months left in the year for more work to be done.

The Tofield Agricultural Society has taken on a very ambitious project this summer, seeing a complete rehabilitation of the Arena floor, and underground cooling brine lines. This extensive project has forged forward and continues to see an estimated completion date in late September. This timeline coincides with the beginning of “ice season” for the Arena. The completion of this project will ensure success for the on-ice Arena operations for years to come.

Mayor and Council are very pleased to welcome Dacro Industries to the community. Dacro will be occupying the former KNM building and will be producing oilfield pressure vessels. Dacro is an Edmonton based company and have been successfully operating since the 1970s. Having increased development, and economic development is a strong stance of Council. The addition of this business to the community will help to increase community awareness and could see the potential for employment opportunities in the future.

Mayor and Council are also pleased to welcome Wild Rose

CO-OP to Tofield. Wild Rose is currently constructing a fueling card lock facility on the West end of Tofield, which will also house a feed, oil, and agricultural needs centre on site. This development is expected to see completion towards the later part of 2022.

The pumptrack project is still forging forward, and we, collectively are looking at the September time frame for construction. Although the project has been delayed through means beyond our control, it is still fully expected that this project will be completed in 2022. The longstanding benefits of this project are sure to be enjoyed by those both in Tofield, as well as

the surrounding area. Truly, this can be a further drawing card for the community.

The remainder of 2022 stands to see further developments which continue to be worked on, and once further information is available, it will be relayed by Mayor and Council. The areas of economic development stand at our forefront, and Council will continue to strive towards change and success in these areas and have the true beauty of Tofield known throughout the province and beyond.
