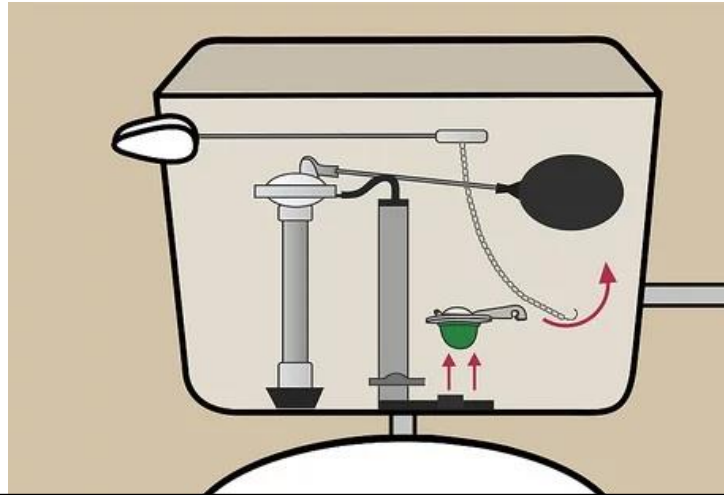


Leaking Toilets are the #1 cause of large water bills



**Faulty toilets can cost hundreds of dollars**

The average American Standard Toilet uses approximately 18 litres of water per flush. A toilet running full flow will fill up a bath tub in six minutes, or a swimming pool in one month.

**HOW TO TEST IF YOUR TOILET HAS A SILENT LEAK?**

To check for a toilet leak using food coloring, simply drop a few drops into the toilet tank, wait 15-20 minutes, and then check the bowl for colored water; if you see color, you have a leak.

How does the Town of Tofield know there is a leak?

When we do a meter read, our system flags accounts that water is going through the meter every 15 minutes for 30 + days.
